## APM Terminals Receives Lloyd's List Port Infrastructure Development of the Year

intermodal development. Of the 45 finalists in the Americas, only 15 maritime companies or ports receive this award. ## Alabama Power's Plant Barry Recognized with Plant Operational Excellence Award

Alabama Power's Barry Steam Plant in Mobile County has been recognized by Navigant Consulting Generation Knowledge Service (GKS) with a Plant Operational Excellence Award.



These awards recognize coal-fired and combined cycle power plants that have demonstrated excellence in cost and operational management, as well as improved performance and reliability. Plant Barry received the runner-up award in the Combined Cycle Category. The GKS Plant Operational Excellence Awards are based on a review of cost and performance data over the most recent five-year period (2013-2017.) Winners were selected after a detailed analysis of cost and performance data from Navigant's industry leading GKS database, which contains data on more than 230,000 megawatts of coal-fired generation and nearly 85,000 megawatts of combined cycle generation. Plant Barry Combined Cycle units have been led for the last 5 years by O & M (Operations and Maintenance) Manager Adam Davis.
