Compliance: Methane Emission Reductions

In May 2018, the ExxonMobil Mobile Bay team initiated a greenhouse gas reduction plan to mitigate environmental

impacts in Mobile Bay. This plan was developed by employees at the Mobile Bay Site and its execution served as the flagship of the company's voluntary commitment to the American Petroleum Institute (API) Environmental Partnership Program. Starting in July 2018, the offshore operations team replaced all 50 pneumatic valve controllers with 75% lower natural gas consuming alternatives. This resulted in reducing methane emissions by 75 tons per year. Overall, about 3.5 million standard cubic feet of natural gas per year can be reallocated for sale to the Mobile, Alabama community instead of being released to the environment.
