ABOUT THE PEP ENVIRONMENTAL STEWARSHIP AWARDS:

The PEP Board of Directors is currently seeking applicants for the 2023 PEP Environmental Stewardship Member Awards. Since 2005, the PEP Board of Directors has presented annual awards to recognize PEP members whose work has made a significant and positive contribution to the Gulf Coast region in three crucial areas: economic growth, environmental health and social responsibility.

AWARD ELIBILITY:

- PEP member companies can self-nominate their company, a project partner or co-nominate with another partner on a multi-faceted project.
- The applicant and at least one significant project partner must be a PEP member.
- The project location should be in the Central Gulf Coast region and completed in the last 12-18 months.
- The project should demonstrate innovative environmental best practices in manufacturing, construction, engineering, conservation or restoration.
- Company-led service projects that result in environmental restoration or conservation are also eligible.

Please note, businesses of all sizes have won this award based on the project's innovation, not simply the overall size of the project's environmental impact.

After the 2023 award recipients have been selected, PEP's PR consultant will reach out to the award recipients. The applicant will be asked to provide marketing materials to contribute to a brief video that will prepared for each award. It is extremely helpful if the applicant can provide professional photos and b-roll video clips of your project and company in general. The consultant will also reach out if she has questions about your project and to obtain quotes for the content we will develop for the website, newsletter and press release.

ITEM 3: PROJECT SUMMARY (REQUIRED)

In 250 words or less, provide a summary of the project and its overall significance and environmental benefits. (PEP may use this summary for the event brochure and press materials.)

ITEM 4: ATTACH A PROJECT NARRATIVE (REQUIRED)

The project narrative should describe the measurable impacts of the company's project and how the project has made a significant and positive contribution to the Gulf Coast region in three crucial areas: economic growth, environmental health and social responsibility.

The narrative should include

- A short description of what the company does.
- The problem being addressed.
- A description of any innovative or unique approaches that were used.
- The environmental impact, both immediate and long-term.
- The project's measurable results, such as material diverted from disposal, cost savings, revenue generated, and reduction in greenhouse gas emissions, etc.
- Any additional information explaining the beneficial impact on the community, such as jobs created. Will you be training others to replicate or share the innovation at other sites or in other applications?
- Project partners that should be recognized as part of the project's success.

Jargon and technical explanations should be kept to a minimum and explained in laymen's terms as appropriate. Consider providing easy to understand comparable results: i.e., the amount of greenhouse gas reduced is equivalent to x # of cars annually.

The narrative should provide even more detail than the summary in Item 3, but no more than two pages typed and double-spaced.

ITEM 6: PHOTOS AND VIDEO

All photographs and video submitted must include copyright permission. Submit photos by email as a JPEG or TIFF file at 300 dpi resolution or higher.

ITEM 6: SUSTAINABILITY POLICY STATEMENT (NOT REQUIRED)

In addition to the narrative, you may include a brief paragraph outlining the company's current best environmental practices and the company's sustainability mission or policy statement.

APPLICATION DEADLINE: NO LATER THAN 5 P.M. ON MARCH 15, 2023
